Mobile Phone and Electronic Device Policy

We recognise that in today's society many people feel it necessary to carry mobile phones. With the advent of pre-paid and cheap phones many children are given phones providing parents and children with access to each other when needed.

Please remember that the school can be contacted on 8254 8322 between 8:30 and 3:30 each day. If you require a message to your child, please contact the school before 2:30pm. We cannot guarantee messages will be delivered after this time.

Unfortunately, although providing an extra level of security, a large number of students misuse their phones while at school. It is important to understand that it is illegal to harass or bully others via voice or text messages or to take and/or displaying inappropriate images on a phone.

At Munno Para Primary School we would prefer that students did not bring mobile phones or other electronic devices to school *at all*.

STUDENTS

- Students are strongly discouraged from bringing mobile phones and/or electronic devices to school but if they do so they must:-
 - Sign their phone in at the Front Office and pick it up at the end of the day

Students caught with mobile phones or other electronic devices during school time or who are unwilling to comply with the above request will be subject to the school's Behaviour Policy.

STAFF

- While the carrying of mobile phones on yard duty is encouraged, mobile phones are *not* to be used during teaching time.
- All mobile phones must be turned off or put on 'silent' during meetings.

PARENTS/CARERS and VISITORS

- All parents/carers and visitors are asked to switch their phones to silent or discreet when in classrooms, meetings or attending school functions such as Assemblies, Acquaintance Night, Interviews and other school events.

The school has a mobile phone for school events and the number can be given out on such occasions.
